CODE OF CONDUCT
POLICY

All spectators must meet the following requirements in regards to conduct during any BHFC activity or activity sanctioned by HFI:

- 1.Respect the decisions of Match Officials and teach children to do the same.
- 2. Never harrass, put undue pressure on, ridicule or unduly scold a child for making a mistake -positive comments are motivational, negative comments are harmful.
- 3.Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their gender, ability, race, colour, religion, language, politics, national or ethnic origin.
- 4.Not engage in discrimination, harassment, or abuse in any form, towards any player, official or other spectator, including the use of obscene or offensive language or gestures, the incitement of hatred or violence or partaking in indecent or racist chanting.
- 5.Not engage in discrimination, harassment, or abuse in any form that incites player aggression or Violence.
- 6.Must not use violence in any form, whether it is against other spectators, Team Officials (including coaches), Match Officials or Players. This includes verbal aggression and threatening or intimidating behaviour.
- 7.Must follow all instruction of a Ground official, Team official, BHFC official or HFI representative.
- 8.Immediately leave a playing venue when asked by a ground official, team official or HFI representative.
- 9.Must comply with any terms of entry of a venue, including bag inspections, prohibited and restricted items such as flares, missiles, dangerous articles and items that have the potential to cause injury or public nuisance.
- 10. Must not throw missiles (including on to the field of play or at other spectators) and must not enter the field of play or its surrounds without lawful authority.
- 11. Must conduct themselves in a manner that enhances, rather than injures, the reputation and goodwill of BHFC and football generally.
- 12. Must not drink or use illicit substances at a game or training or be drunk or under the influence of illicit substances at a club event.
