

TH #2 field Set Up



Thankyou for volunteering to set up the full sized field: TH #2

The field set up must be completed 20 minutes prior to kick off of the first full sized game of the day.

TH #2 is used every Saturday morning for miniroos games. You may set up after these games as long as the field is ready for the full sized game kick off.



CHANGE ROOM END TH #2.

What you need:

Each field has equipment and signage that is specific to that field. It is labelled as such.

Please don't take items out of other bins. Each bin is set up with what your field needs.

Each field has:

- * 2 x goal nets
- * 2 x bench seats
- * 1 x tub (pegs/mallet)
- * ¼ line markers
- * Rubbish bin
- * Signs
- * Corner flags
- * Step ladder



Nets

Please be careful when getting the nets out. If they are tangled in buckets or pegs you will tear them.

The net clips are on the goal posts. If you need more contact Tony or Cath asap.

Don't forget to secure the back of the net with tent pegs

Put the ladder, bucket with mallet etc back in the wheelie bin.

Leave the wheelie bin behind the goal at the car park end of the field ready for the team packing up.

Leave the wheelie bin, bucket, & ladder behind the goal at the far end of the field so it is not mistaken for a rubbish bin



Corner flags



6 x corner flags are required for TH #1. ●

1 corner flag is placed at each corner of the field.

1 corner flag is placed on either side of the field at the half way line.

Be careful when you put the corner flags in the ground. If the ground is hard you will snap them.

If you break one please let us know asap.



CHANGE ROOM END TH #2.

Benches & Bin



Benches are provided for teams to sit in the Technical Area.

No spectators or parents are permitted on these benches in the Technical Area.

Each field has 1 bench for the home team, and one bench for the opposition team.

Place the rubbish bin between each field's benches.

The benches & rubbish bin will be at the field already- having been used for the miniroos games earlier in the morning.



CHANGE ROOM END TH #2.

1/4 line markers

1/4 line markers ● are used to mark areas for U8 - U13 games.

The yellow 1/4 line markers will be at the field, having been used by the miniroos in the previous games.



Each field has 4 quarter line markers that are placed just outside the sideline of each field. (approx 50cm from the line)

1/4 line markers are placed half way between the centre of the field and the goal box.

Referee chairs

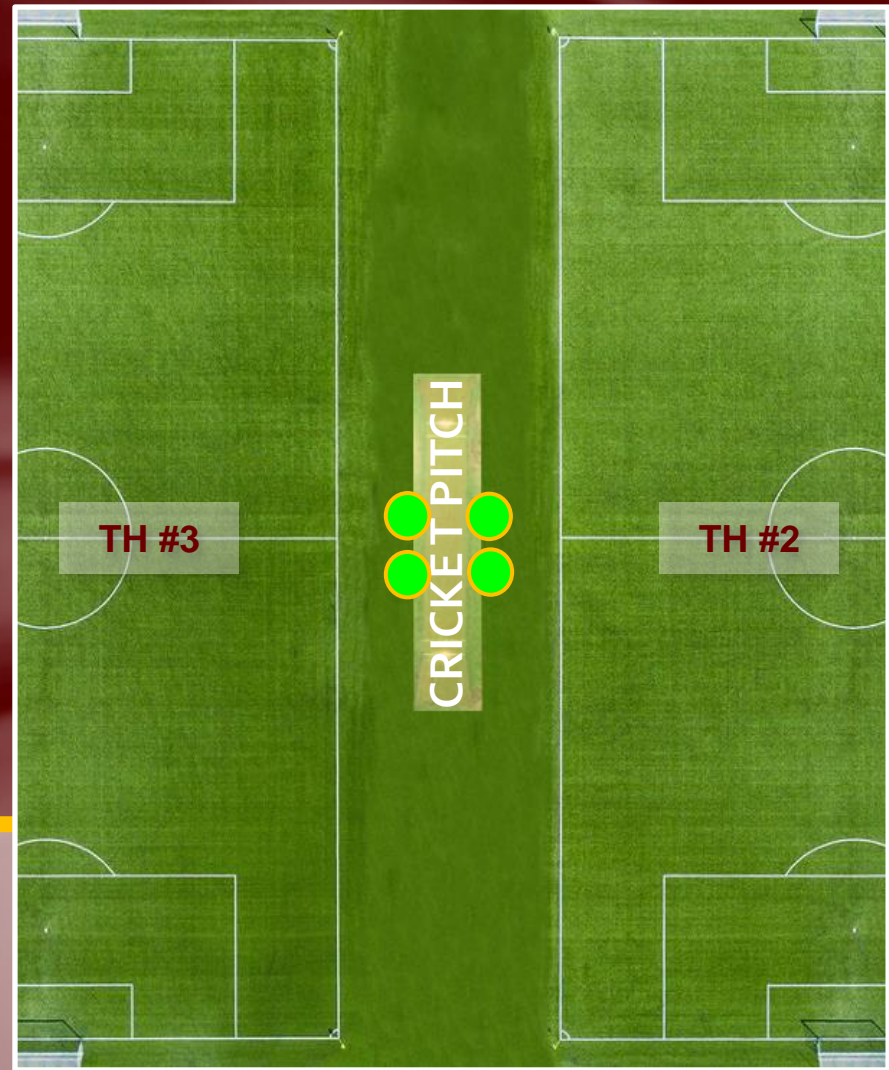
Plastic chairs ● are supplied for the referees.

Place two plastic chairs facing field 2 and two plastic chairs facing field 3.

Signs

Signs are used for identification and safety, as well as to advise all of football and ground regulations.

Each sign has a specific position. The text on the sign is the best indicator of where it is placed.

Place spectator signs so they are facing out from the field.

Any signs cable tied to the fence don't need to be packed away.
